Fulda Gap MEGA Game, October 6-8: The first of its kind on the East Coast

Command Decisions Paintball is very proud to present one of the first recurring Mid-Atlantic Coast "mega scenario games" this coming October. The game will be held from Friday, Oct. 6 through Sunday, Oct. 8. The field, with over 60 acres, hopes to host a minimum of 300 players but realistically plans to have approximately 500 players in attendance.

The scenario "**Fulda Gap**" is a hypothetical re-creation of a portion of an overall attack on West Germany by the Warsaw Pact. The area surrounding Fulda would have been an obvious route for the Soviet attack into West Germany in an effort to seize the all-important industrial and financial center of the country and the Rhine/Main River crossings around Frankfurt.

In this battle, NATO forces will attempt to defeat the Soviet forces. Armored divisions will be represented and tank battles will ensue. Also hanging over the battlefield is the very "real" threat posed by chemical and nuclear weapons. Combined with a determination by the West to stop the Soviet juggernaut at any cost and the USSR's hunger for the rich territories of central Europe,

the use of these terrible weapons of destruction becomes a real possibility. Now it is up to you to determine the outcome of the opening moves of World War III.

Pre-registration is now open at www.scenariosupply.com at a cost of \$50 for the weekend of play, which includes all day/night air. Pre-registration will end on Friday, September 29th at midnight after which time the full registration rate of \$60.00 will apply. Camping is available on a first come, first served basis but there is plenty of room. RV's are welcome but there are no hookups. Food and paintball vendors will be on site and we welcome any vendors wanting to participate to contact us as soon as possible!
